Dear Carol Marshall:

On June 15, 2021, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received the City of Port Angeles decision on your Shoreline Variance Permit for the development of a 49-square-foot deck off the upper floor of an existing single-family residence, within a vegetation conservation area of the “shoreline residential” environmental designation of Segment B of the Port Angeles Shoreline Master Program.

By law, Ecology must review Variance Permits for compliance with:

- The Shoreline Management Act (Chapter 90.58 RCW)
- Ecology’s Variance Permit approval criteria (Chapter 173-27-170 WAC)
- The City of Port Angeles Shoreline Master Program.

After reviewing Variance Permits for compliance, Ecology must decide whether to approve, approve with conditions, or disapprove them.

Our Decision: Ecology approves your Variance Permit, provided your project complies with the conditions required by City of Port Angeles. **Please note, however, that other federal, state, and local permits may be required in addition to this shoreline permit.**

What Happens Next?

Before you begin activities authorized by this permit, the law requires you to wait at least 21 days from the date of this letter, the “date of filing.” This waiting period allows anyone (including you) who disagrees with any aspect of this permit, to appeal the decision to the state Shorelines Hearings Board.

You must wait for the conclusion of an appeal before you can begin the activities authorized by this permit.



The most current appeal will appear on top.
