Overview

The City and community of Port Angeles is developing a Climate Resiliency Plan **to inventory and reduce its community and municipal greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions while building resilience to climate change impacts and related stressors**. The City wants to achieve carbon neutrality by 2030, which exceeds WA State GHG Emissions reduction goals, established in E2SHB 2311 and RCW 70A.45.020.

The Port Angeles Climate Resiliency Plan will **build on current and prior work and identify new opportunities** for **ambitious, feasible, and equitable** climate action that reduces Port Angeles' GHG emissions and builds readiness for climate impacts like sea level rise and increased flooding.

Public outreach and participation are essential to this process, and the City is committed to centering equity and respect for all community members. This will lead to a Climate Resiliency Plan that reflects the communities' priorities and values, builds capacity and interest in sustainable behavioral change from residents, and increases the community buy-in that is important for successful long-term implementation of the Resiliency Plan. This is the first of two Public Workshops to support the development of the Port Angeles Climate Resiliency Plan. The **workshop will focus on developing actions to include in the Climate Resiliency Plan**.
