WHO: General public are provided notice at City Hall. Stakeholders and all community members are provided notice indirectly in the Peninsula Daily News, the City’s website, at the proposal’s location, and at City Hall (321 East 5th Street).

WHAT: The City of Port Angeles received a development application, see application details below. This application follows an administrative process with an internal decision by the Director of Community and Economic Development. There will be no public hearing held for this decision. HOW TO COMMENT: Interested parties are encouraged to comment on the proposal and may request a copy of the decision once it’s been made and any appeal rights. Any interested parties may submit written comment during the 14-day public comment period. Written comments must be submitted prior to the close of the public comment period to ced@cityofpa.us.

HEARING PARTICIPATION: This decision is administrative and therefore no public hearing will take place. Written public comment provided on or before to 5/3/2022 will be the only chance for the public to provide testimony prior to an administrative decision.

STATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT: A Determination of Non-Significance has been issued for the project on 4/19/2022. This comment period will be the only time to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposed project, per WAC 197-11-340. Written comment directed toward SEPA must be submitted to the Department of Community & Economic Development (DCED) ced@cityofpa.us, no later than 5/3/2022. Interested parties are encouraged to comment on the proposal and may request a copy of the decision. Comments on the determination or proposal shall be as specific as possible and may address either the adequacy of the environmental document or the merits of the alternatives discussed or both. The SEPA official may retain or modify the DNS, or if the official determines that significant adverse impacts are likely, withdraw the DNS or supporting documents. Any appeal of this determination shall be filed within 14 days after the date of the Determination of Non-Significance issued on 4/19/2022.
