

PORT ANGELES PARKS, RECREATION & BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION MEETING

CALL TO ORDER – REGULAR MEETING: Commissioner Collins called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: Commissioner Hodgson moved to approve January 19, 2023 minutes. Commissioner McGuire seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

DIRECTOR’S REPORT:

- 1. City Pier Railing Delay:** Director Delikat discussed the delay of the City Pier Railing project. This rescheduling is caused by a holdup from the company completing the hot dip galvanization. The project is rescheduled to start February 27, 2023.
- 2. Shane Park Update:** Shane Park has been experiencing standing water on the west side of the park. The cause is likely due to a recent Public Works project where a nearby sewer line needed to be sleeved. Now ground water that was going into the sewer line has no place to go. In the near future, Director Delikat will be meeting with Public Works Engineering Department to see if a solution is possible.
- 3. Parks Maintenance & Facility Shop:** The Parks Maintenance Crew completed their two month move into a new workshop that is larger than their last facility that was off of “O” Street.
- 4. Senior Center Manager Update:** The current Senior Center Manager, Aubry Bright, is resigning her position with the City of Port Angeles on March 1, 2023. With the assistance of other City staff, Manager Bright assured that the Senior Center will run self sufficient until the position is filled.
