DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS): The lead agency has determined that this project does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 43.21C.030 (2)(c). This decision was made after a review of a completed environmental checklist, a notice using the SEPA DNS process, and other information on file with the lead agency. APPEALS: Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 43.21C.060 allows an appeal of any decision by a non-elected local official. Any appeal of the threshold determination of the SEPA Responsible Official must be made to the Superior Court within 21 days of the date the DNS is final. The appeal must be in writing. An appeal of this determination must be based on non-compliance with RCW 43.21, WAC 197-11, or Chapter 15.04 PAMC. An open record public hearing on the SEPA appeal shall be before the Superior Court.
